1. Meeting called to order at 3:05 pm.

8. Mapping project update:

Susanne to continue to gather feedback on the questionnaire prepared by the U of Vic students. The intent is to complete the map before Christmas.

9. **Fundraising**:

- Sometime in the fall we will need to start asking businesses to contribute money to have their logo on the map;
- Susanne to find out whether it is worthwhile writing a proposal for a community gaming grant;

- Lynn to ask Thriftys for a significant donation in exchange for being featured on the map; and
- Susanne to contact the TD Bank to see if they would give us a grant.
